The Bond of the Riverhead Electric Light Co., with Sureties, J. Henry Perkins and T. M. Griffing was presented and on motion the Bond approved and the Clerk instructed to endorse the approval thereon. ✓

The Co.,, on Electric Lights made the following report: which was accepted and recommendation therein adopted. To the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead.

WE, the undersigned, your Committee on Electric Lights do hereby report that we have examined the street lights

in the Lighting Dist. and carefully looked over the ground and consulted as to the best possible distribution of the 78 lights at our command and do recommend that said lights be located at the following places, viz:-

Board.

3.15 P.M. Town Board reassembled. Same members present. Justice Buckingham offered the following resolution which was adopted.

RESOLVED: that there be assessed and levied upon the taxable property within the Town of Riverhead an amount not to exceed the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50) to defray the expenses of the observance of Memorial Day, by Henry A. Barnum Post, G. A. R. of the Town of Riverhead. Such moneys to be paid by the Supervisor, upon vouchers duly attested by the Commander or Quartermaster of said Post.
