

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office April 12, 1910 at 1.30 p. m.

Meeting called for the purpose of auditing the accounts of the Supervisor.

Supervisor Homan submitted his report for the year.

The report was gone over in detail and after examining the same it was approved as rend red.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, that the Supervisor be instructed to prepare an itemized report showing the disbursements of all monies of which he is the custodian, including the Highway Monies disbursed during the year, to whom paid and for what kind of work or material and that the same be published in the local papers at as early a date as possible.

On motion the Town Superintendent was instructed to specify in his orders on the Supervisor for the payment of

highway money, the road on which the work mentioned in the order was performed and be it

Further Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Town Superintendent.

Justice Hildreth presented several communications between Town Supt. Edwards and the State Highway Commission relative to certain work performed on the Riverhead-Quogue state road by Supt. Edwards. On motion the communications were received and ordered filed.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Town Supt. of Highways of the Town of Riverhead be allowed the sum of \$42 for clerical work to date to offset the amount received from the State for his services rendered in the state road.

On motion the Supervisor was instructed to transfer from the Contingent Fund to the credit of the Town Poor Fund the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or as much thereof as may be necessary.

On motion the Supervisor was instructed to transfer from the Contingent Fund to the credit of the Board of Health the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or as much thereof as may be necessary.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the resolution adopted at a meeting of t

the Town Board held on Nov. 5, 1909 relative to the amount of compensation allowed the Supervisor for his services under Sec. 110 of the Highway Law be hereby repealed.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Supervisor be allowed the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) for his services under Sec. 110 of the Highway Law for the year 1910, in lieu of all other compensation for the disbursement of the Highway Monies.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the attention of the Town Supt. of Highways be called to the condition of the Town Dock.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
