Dayton in the suit, gave his views on the suit and claim.

On motion \$500 from the general fund was ordered to be paid to the Overseer of the Poor.

Justices Taft, Buckingham and Daniel R. Young filed their reports of fines collected.

On motion the report of Oliver A. Terry, Overseer of the Poor was approved.

The report of the Supervisor was presented and examined and on motion the same was approved.

On motion the report of Charles S. Edwards, Highway Commissioner was approved.

30 bills amounting to \$740.33 were audited.
