

Minutes of the Town Meeting of the Town of Riverhead held at the Town Clerk's Office Thursday, Sept. 13, 1900 at 2.30 P.M. pursuant to call of the Town Clerk by reason of the death of the Supervisor, Henry L. Hallock

Justice Daniel R. Young was selected Chairman.

A Petition with 272 signatures of Republican and Democratic electors was presented to the Board requesting the appointment of Henry A. Hallock, son of Henry L. Hallock, as Supervisor.

Remarks were made by several members of the Board as to the qualifications of the person to be appointed to the effect, that it required a man of mature age and business experience to discharge the duties of Supervisor.

Justice Buckingham presented the name of Geo. L. Wells; Justice Payne presented the name of Samuel Rowley and Jus-

tice D. R. Young presented the name of Henry A. Hallock to fill the vacancy.

On motion of Justice Buckingham an informal ballot was ordered and the Clerk instructed to act as Teller.

The Ballot was taken with the following result.

- John Bagshaw 2
- Henry A. Hallock 1

Mr. Bagshaw requested that his name be dropped.

On motion a formal Ballot was ordered and resulted as follows:-

- John Bagshaw 2
- Henry A. Hallock 1

On motion of John Bagshaw, George L. Wells was appointed to fill the vacancy.

On motion of Geo. A. Buckingham the Petition was ordered on file
