

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, August 7th, 1940 at 2:00 P. M.

Solomon Raffé, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting held on July 24th, 1940 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Wading River Civic Association urging the Board not to change in any way the present course of the North Wading River Road, but instead to place larger warning signs wherever it may be considered necessary. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A copy of a communication from the Corn Exchange Bank Trust Company to W. Germond Cochran, Agent, requesting the Board to increase their rent from \$10.00 to \$25.00 per month for the MacDonald property on Griffing Avenue, now used for a Town Parking Field. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A resolution was read from the Board of Supervisors fixing Monday, November 25th, 1940 as the date of the meeting at which taxes for the next fiscal year will be levied. The resolution was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead express their thanks to Mr. Arthur Gross of Laurel, New York, for his kindness in furnishing drinking water to the bathers on the beach at the foot of Laurel Lane and Peconic Bay at Laurel. The resolution was adopted by unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the resolution adopted May 1st, 1940 authorizing the Long Island Lighting Company to place one 80 C. P. street light on Pole #2 on East Avenue Extension and one 80 C.P. street light on Pole #5 on Frankling Street, Riverhead Lighting District be and the same is hereby rescinded and be it further

RESOLVED that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place one 80 C.P. street light on Pole #3 on East Avenue Extension and one 80 C.P. street light on Pole #5 on Franklin Street, Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Town bills for the month of *July*, 1940.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, August 21st, 1940 at 2:00 P. M.
