

MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Tuesday July 22, 1913 at 4:00.P.M.

PRESENT:

On motion the Supervisor and two Justices were authorized to appoint two Special Constables for a period of not exceeding 90 days and to be on duty as many days as the Supervisor may deem necessary and that said Special Constables be paid a compensation of \$3.00 per day for each days services performed as such Special Constables.

On motion the Supervisor was authorized to purchase in the name of the Town of Riverhead from John W. Fanning for the sum of \$75.00 a parcel of land at Baiting Hollow three rods wide connecting Osborn Avenue or Mill Road with North Road.

On motion it was ordered that the Town pay all the expenses of Searching Title; preparing and recording papers and surveying the property, incurred in acquiring above property of John W. Fanning.
