MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town
of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Friday
September 5th, 1913, at 2:00 P.M.

PRESENT:

On motion, it was ordered that Supervisor have six
Special Deputy Sheriffs appointed to act during the days
and nights of the Fair and during week beginning September
15th, 1913. It being understood that three of such Deputies
are to act during the daytime and three during the nighttime.

On motion the following resolution was adopted and
order published:

Resolved that no person, firm or corporation shall
operate, in the Town of Riverhead, vehicles for the trans-
portation of passengers or for trucking purposes, during
the week commencing Monday, September 15th, 1913, without
having first procured from the Town Clerk of said Town a
license for the operation thereof according to the following
schedule, namely:

For each auto bus carrying ten (10) passengers or
less, \$10.00

For each auto bus carrying an excess of ten (10)
passengers, \$15.00.

For horse-drawn stages, \$5.00 for each stage.

For trucks, \$5.00 for each person, firm or corporation, which license shall permit each person, firm or corporation to operate an unlimited number of trucks.

The licenses above enumerated are granted under the express condition that operators of all vehicles shall strictly comply with all the rules and traffic regulations and park all cars, stages or other vehicles on the right hand side of the highway in the direction in which the vehicle is headed.

Any person, firm or corporation operating a vehicle or vehicles without having first procured a license therefor as herein provided or failing to comply with the terms of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall also be liable to a penalty of \$25.00 for each and every violation thereof.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately

On motion, Supervisor [unclear] was authorized to procure three uniforms for Special Deputy Sheriffs

On motion it was ordered that a License be granted "Millers Excelsior shows" on payment of License fee of \$2.00 to conduct a Carnival on grounds corner of Osborne and Lincoln Avenues in Village of Riverhead for 10 days beginning Saturday, September 6th, 1913.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
