Councilman Grodski offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Young.

WHEREAS Northville Industries Corporation has made application to the Corps of Engineers for permission to make a substantial improvement on their offshore facilities at Northville in the Town of Riverhead, and

WHEREAS, the said improvements are designed to insure greater safety insofar as the exchange of fuel oil from ship to shore is concerned, and

RESOLUTION continued:

WHEREAS, there were substantial questions as to whether or not the proposal will in effect be helpful to the maintenance of the purity of the waters of Long Island Sound and vicinity, and

WHEREAS, an informational meeting was held at Riverhead on June 28, 1971, and


WHEREAS, the danger of oil spillage is ever present in such a facility, and WHEREAS, it <sup>was</sup> demonstrated by experts in the field that the danger of oil spillage pollution would be substantially reduced by the proposed improvement of the installation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead unanimously requests that the Corps of Engineers approve the application so that the construction of the improvement may commence as soon as possible so as to protect our valuable shoreline.

The vote, Councilman Young, Yes, Councilman Grodski, Yes, Town Justice Leonard, Yes, Town Justice Costello, Yes, and Supervisor Zaloga, Yes.

The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.
