

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, December 9, 1931 at 2 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board held November 25, 1931 were read and on motion and vote duly adopted.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the Town Clerk be and he hereby is allowed the sum of \$200.00 election expenses for the year 1931.

On motion and vote, the Town Clerk was authorized to have notice relative to the 1932 dog licenses published four times in each of the local papers.

Acting on a request from the Planning Board, it was Resolved that this Board meet with said Planning Board of the Town of Riverhead, on Thursday evening, December 17, 1931 at 7:30 P.M. in the Town Board meeting Room.

A bill from Laurence E. Hulse in the amount of \$500.00 for ducks and ducklings said to have been killed by rats from the Town Dump was referred to the highway committee to investigate and report back at a future meeting of the Board.

A petition was presented by taxpayers of Fishel Avenue, requesting that this Board discontinue the side walk tax in the Fishel Avenue Sidewalk District. The Town Clerk was instructed to write and advise that the Town Board of Riverhead could find no law giving it the authority to discontinue said tax.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was

Resolved That the Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead be and he hereby is authorized by this Board to turn over the Town trucks under the supervision of the Town truck drivers to the Emergency Relief Committee for use during the emergency and be it further Resolved That the Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead supervise work done on town highways by said relief workers.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That Justice William L. Miller be and he hereby is appointed a committee to supervise the laying out under ----- Town Relief Proposition No.3, of work on North Wading River Road.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the Town Board does hereby approve of the purchasing of shovels, axes and necessary tools by the Town of Riverhead for use of emergency relief workers in the Town of Riverhead and be it further Resolved That the bill for same be paid from the General Town Fund.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That this Board does hereby approve of the following work to be done under the supervision of the Superintendent of Highways, subject to the approval of the State Emergency Relief Administration.

Project No. 5 - Town Bark Road leading to the Howell M. Reeves Park- widening and improving.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned to meet on Thursday December 17, 1931 at 7:30 P.M.
