Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Friday, January 1, 1943 at 10:00 A. M.

Seth A. Hubbard, Town Attorney was present.

Justice Warner was duly elected Chairman of the Meeting.

Justice Warner welcomed Justice Leonard to the Board and wished him well in his new duties.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that Milton L. Burns, be and he hereby is appointed Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead and that his salary be fixed at the base rate of \$4,000.00 per annum. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Total vote, Yes 4, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that Bond No. 07-25-43 of the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company, bonding Milton L. Burns, as Supervisor in the amount of \$40,000.00 be and the same is hereby approved as to form, manner of execution and the sufficiency of the surety. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that Bond No. 36085 of the Travelers Indemnity Company bonding Milton L. Burns, in the amount of \$107,408.14 for all Highway moneys, be and the same is hereby approved as to form, manner of execution and the sufficiency of the surety. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Town Attorney Hubbard thereupon administered the Oath of Office to Supervisor Burns who was declared duly qualified, and with the congratulations of the Board and all present was escorted to the chair.

Supervisor Burns thanked the Board for the honor that they had bestowed upon him and assured them that he would make every effort to uphold the confidence placed in him.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the employment by the Town of Riverhead of Ralph Gallagher, Paul Guyder, Bruno Zaloga, Jr., Stanley Figurniak and Edward Painter as Special Policemen be terminated as of this date. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher and Leonard, Yes, Justice Smith, Not Voting, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Not Voting 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that John Doscinski be appointed Provisional Officer in Charge of the Special Policemen of the Town of Riverhead and that his salary be fixed at the base rate of \$2000.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher and Leonard, Yes, Justice Smith, Not Voting, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Not Voting 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner, it was RESOLVED that George Cooper, William Shaddock, Stanley Wowak and John Bilski be appointed Provisional Special Policemen of the Town of Riverhead and that their salaries be fixed at the base rate of \$1800.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher and Leonard, Yes, Justice Smith, Not Voting, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Not Voting 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the salaries of William Fleischman, Halsey Corwin and Chester Kowalski, Special Policemen of the Town of Riverhead be fixed at the base rate of \$1800.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that the employment by the Town of Riverhead of Walter Downs as School Traffic Officer be terminated as of this date. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher and Leonard, Yes, Justice Smith, Not Voting, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Not Voting 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice <sup>Warner</sup> Smith, it was RESOLVED that Carl Lewin be appointed School Traffic Officer for School Duty at the Aquebogue School and further

RESOLVED that he serve at the pleasure of the Town Board from the hours of 8:00 A. M. to 9:00 A. M., 11:00 A. M. to 1:00 P. M. and 3:00 P. M. to 4:00 P. M., salary fixed at the rate of 65 cents per hour. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, and Leonard, Yes, Justice Smith, Not Voting, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Not Voting 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the salaries of John M. Burgess, Jr., Fred. MacGlaflin, Vincent Trussler and I. S. Hendrickson, School Traffic Officers for the Town of Riverhead be fixed at the rate of 65 cents per hour. The Justices Warner, Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Warner, it was RESOLVED that the employment by the Town of Riverhead of John Kruszon as Clerk to the Board of Assessors be terminated as of this date. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher and Leonard, Yes, Justice Smith, Not Voting, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Not Voting 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that Frank Yousik be appointed Provisional Senior Clerk to the Board of Assessors and that his salary be fixed at the base rate of \$2100.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher and Leonard, Yes, Justice Smith, Not Voting 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.


On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that the employment by the Town of Riverhead of Stanley Danielowich as Dog Warden, be terminated as of this date. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher and Leonard, Yes, Justice Smith, Not Voting, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Not Voting 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Leonard it was RESOLVED that Theodore Gevinski be appointed Dog Warden for the Town of Riverhead, and that he serve at the pleasure of the Town Board, at the salary fixed by the Agriculture and Markets Law. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher and Leonard, Yes, Justice Smith, Not Voting, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 4, Not Voting 1, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Boutcher, it was RESOLVED that the salary of Alice Miller, Social Investigator in the Welfare Dept. of the Town of Riverhead be fixed at the base rate of \$1600.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly, together with such necessary expenses as may be approved by the Town Board and that the salary of Helen Swotkewicz, Junior Account Clerk in the Welfare Dept. of the Town of Riverhead be fixed at the base rate of \$1350.00 per annum, payable semi-monthly. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that the Riverhead News be designated the Official Newspaper for the Town of Riverhead for the year, 1943. The vote, Justices Warner, Boutcher, Leonard and Smith, Yes, Supervisor Burns, Yes. Total vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the Meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, January 6, 1943 at 2:00 P. M.
