

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, January 3, 1930 at 3 P.M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board of December 23, 1929 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

A communication was read from the Board of Assessors of the Town of Riverhead advising that Byron Rogers had been duly appointed Clerk of the Board of Assessors.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the compensation of Byron Rogers as Clerk of the Board of Assessors be and the same hereby is fixed at \$2000.00 per year.

Supervisor Homan appointed Justice John Fafinski and Justice Albert W. Conklin as the Lighting Committee.

Supervisor Homan appointed Justice Burnside and Justice Conklin as the committee on furniture and fixtures for the new town quarters.

The committee having charge of furnishings for the new quarters advised that it had secured the services of Sidney Jones, Architect, to assist in laying out the new quarters, to advertise for bids for flooring and that fee for these services would not be in excess of \$100.00

The lighting committee was requested to investigate the street lighting conditions on Roanoke Avenue near the school and report at the next meeting of the Town Board.

Jesse W. Payne addressed the Board and requested that the Board pass an ordinance prohibiting the displaying of merchandise on the sidewalks in front of stores in the business section.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That a legal opinion be obtained from Alman G. Rasquin, Attorney, as to the powers of the Town Board to pass and enforce an ordinance prohibiting the displaying of merchandise on the sidewalks in front of stores in the Town.

m The matter of appointing a Town Welfare Officer was taken up and as the law regarding this matter was not clear to the members of the Board, on motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That a legal opinion be obtained from Almon G. Rasquin, Attorney, as to the procedure of the Town Board under this new law.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on January 15, 1930 at 2 P. M.
