

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, April 18, 1951 at 3:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on April 4, 1951 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from Lewis Robbins, President of the Peconic River Park, Inc. requesting that "No Fishing from this Road" signs be placed Forge Road. The letter was referred to the Town Attorney.

A communication was read from Zaleski & Jablonka, Attorneys in regard to a triangular parcel of land formerly part of Pulaski Street at its intersection with Kratoville Ave. The matter was referred to the Town Attorney.

A communication was read from Henry Scheinberg making application for the position of Lifeguard at one of the town beaches this coming summer. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that Henry Scheinberg be appointed Lifeguard at the Iron Pier Beach from June 29, 1951 to Labor Day, inclusive, subject to the approval of the Civil Service Commission, to serve at the pleasure of the Town Board, salary fixed at the rate of \$40.00 per week. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Supervisor's report for the month of March 1951 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of April 16, 1951 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

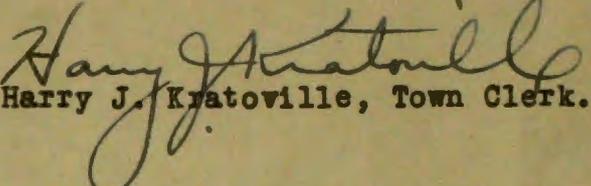
On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead negotiate with the owners of the property adjacent to the Town property and Creek Road, Wading River for the rental price equivalent to the amount of taxes for the year. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Gatz and Leonard Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Gatz it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to

place ~~one~~ 100 C.P. Street Lightson Poles#17^{+ #23} on Marcy Avenue in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date the totals of which ~~were~~ as follows: General Town Fund-\$3,599.05, Highway Machinery Fund-\$746.07.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, May 2, 1951 at 2:00 P.M.
