

Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, June 2, 1943 at 2:00 P. M.

Minutes of meetings held on May 19, 1943 and May 26th, 1943, were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Smith and seconded by Justice Warner, it was RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be authorized to execute a Trespass Right Agreement to the United States Government, covering the Northerly 200' of the presently used oiled surface portion of Roanoke Avenue in the Town of Riverhead, New York, for a period of one year to expire on June 1, 1944, for the nominal consideration of \$1.00. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from Col. Walter F. Barnes expressing his appreciation for the resolution passed by the Town Board in memory of his wife Cora B. Reeve Barnes. The communication was ordered placed on file.


Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes, submitted a report of the amount of taxes collected as of June 1, 1943 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Boutcher and seconded by Justice Leonard, it was RESOLVED that the Long Island Lighting Co., be authorized to place 1 - 80 C. P. Street Lamp on Pole #1852 on Osborn Avenue in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Police Committee submitted the Police report for the month of May, 1943 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Town Bills for the month of May, 1943.

There being no further business on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, June 16, 1943 at 2:00 P. M.
