On motion, Supervisor was authorized to transfer \$300.00 from the contingent fund to the overseer of the poor fund.

On motion, Supervisor was authorized to transfer the sum of \$500.00 from the contingent to the Superintendent of Highways fund.


On motion, the Supervisor was authorized to insert in the Tax Levy for the year 1913, \$1600.00 for audited bills.

On motion, the Supervisor was authorized to pay August Lewin, \$28.00 out of the Dog fund for Seven Angora Goats killed *by* Dogs.

On motion, the Supervisor was authorized to have a Telephone of the Baiting Hollow and Roanoke Telephone Company installed in some convenient part of the Village of Riverhead for the use of the Night Watchman or Firemen.

On motion, the Supervisor was authorized to purchase a Protectograph to cost \$30.00
