

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 1, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on August 18, 1948 and minutes of a public hearing at Wading River on August 27, 1948 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A petition signed by approximately 122 residents and taxpayers respectfully requesting the Board to submit to the voters at the next election the question as to the acceptance of the so-called Griffing Park property, instead of the Board itself, accepting same was presented to the Board and ordered placed on file.

Mr. Grant Adams addressed the Board and urged that they reconsider the acceptance of Griffing Park property on their own motion and hold a referendum on the matter at the next election.


On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Mico Art Bronze Company the sum of \$1013.80, said sum being one half of the gross collection from the parking meters during the month of August, 1948 as per the agreement between the Town of Riverhead and the said Mico Art Bronze Company. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from Vail Motor Corporation, West Main Street, Riverhead, N.Y. stating that it has a 1948 Pontiac Streamliner 8 Cylinder Sedan Coupe ready to fulfill the order pursuant to a resolution of the Town Board of July 21, 1948, ^{however} advising that the price of the car has increased from \$1796.00 as quoted at that time to the present price of \$1921.00. The communication was ordered placed on file.

The Police Report for the month of August 1948 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 15, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.
