On motion the request was granted.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Whereas, there is no w pending before the  
Legislature of the State of New York a proposed bill to  
abolish the present State Highway Commission and


Whereas, such Commission has proven to be in the  
Town of (Riverhead and the County of Suffolk and throughout  
the State of New York, the most effective, business-like  
and satisfactory manner yet devised in this state for the  
management of the money appropriated for highways throughout  
the State of New York, now be it,

Resolved, that we, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead in regular meeting assembled on this 6<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1911 do hereby emphatically protest against the abolition of the said Highway Commission and a return to the former un-business-like and costly administration of Highway affairs in this State and be it further

Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be spread on the minutes and that a copy thereof be forwarded by the Town Clerk to our representatives in both houses of the Legislature of the State of New York.

On motion the Supervisor was instructed to transfer the sum of \$500 from the Contingent Fund to the credit of the Town Poor Fund.
