Minutes of a joint meeting of the Town Board and the Superintendent of Highways held in Town Hall and in the Town Clerk's Office, Tuesday, April 18th, 1911 at 1:30 O'clock P.M.

Meeting called for the purpose of entering into an agreement for the apportionment of the Highway Moneys for the year 1911.

A number of Taxpayers were present and after a very careful and thorough investigation as to the needs of road improvement throughout the town for coming year, and after a number of citizens were heard relative to various roads, an agreement for apportionment of Highway Moneys was entered into between the Town Board of Riverhead Town and Town Superintendent of Highways, Charles S. Edwards and a copy of said agreement duly filed in the Town Clerk's Office.

A Petition was presented, signed by more than twenty-five Taxpayers, praying that Town Board of Riverhead Town pass a resolution in conformity to Section 62, of the High-

way Law authorizing the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead to construct and maintain sidewalks in Village of Riverhead.

As the above mentioned Petition did not conform to Section 62 of the Highway Law no action was taken relative to same by the Town Board.

A further Petition was presented signed by more than twenty five Taxpayers, same quoting from Section 62 of Highway Law and reading as follows.

TO THE TOWN SUPERINTENDENT

and the

TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD

WE, the undersigned, resident Taxpayers in School District No. 5 of the Town of Riverhead do hereby petition that the sidewalks in the said District hereinafter mentioned be constructed, maintained and repaired at a cost not to exceed \$500. providing and upon the express condition that the owners of property along said route, and other Taxpayers contribute for such construction one half the cost thereof, and the other half, not exceeding the sum of \$500. to be paid in the same manner as other Town charges.

PROPOSED ROUTE

Roanoke Avenue, both sides, South of the Railroad.

First Street, both sides.

Second Street, both sides, from Griffing Avenue to East Street.

Third Street, both sides.

A further Petition was presented signed by more than Twenty-Five Taxpayers, same quoting from Section 62 of the Highway Law and reading as follows:

TO THE TOWN SUPERINTENDENT

and the

TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD

WE, the undersigned, resident Taxpayers in School District No. 5 of the Town of Riverhead, do hereby petition that the sidewalks in the said District hereinafter mentioned be constructed, maintained and repaired at a cost not to exceed \$750 and that the cost for such construction be paid in the same manner as other Town charges:

Roanoke Avenue, both sides, South of Railroad.

First Street, both sides.

Second Street, both sides from Griffing Avenue to East Street.

Third Street, both sides.

SIGNED BY 27 TAXPAYERS

On Motion of Justice David E. Warner the last two mentioned Petitions were laid on the table until State Commissioner of Highways was consulted relative to this Boards authority relative to same

On Motion Town Clerk was instructed to write State Commissioner of Highways for advise as to this Boards powers under Section 62 of the Highway Law.

On Motion Bills of Ex Overseer of the Poor LeRoy P. Reeve were referred to the Town Board of Audit.

On Motion Supervisor Corwin was instructed to transfer Five Hundred Dollars from Contingent Fund to Credit of Board of Health fund.

On Motion Town Clerk was instructed to make copies, of list showing apportionment of Highway Money, for each Justice of the Peace, for Supervisor, for Town Clerk and for Town Superintendent of Highways.

On Motion it was ordered that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor execute Bond in the sum of \$35000 for Highway Moneys.

On Motion it was ordered that ex Supervisor Homan be paid \$250 for disbursing Road Moneys and also \$10 for Searching Title to Road in West part of Riverhead Village-

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
