

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, November 17, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on November 3, 1948 at 2:00 P.M. and minutes of a Budget Hearing held on November 3, 1948 at 7:30 P.M. were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

The request of Anthony Wiwihar Jr. for permission to use approximately 100 feet of the north end of the property on Harrison Avenue for a parking field was discussed by the Board. The said property is now rented by the Town, the south part of which is being used by the Highway Department. It was the consensus of opinion of the Board that it had no objection to the above request, providing a fence is built along the south boundary and adequate liability insurance is carried.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Town Clerk be authorized to give notice that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead will consider the purchase of machinery for the Highway Department in excess of \$500.00 at a meeting to be held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, December 15, 1948 at 2:00 P.M. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

The matter of placing an additional Police Patrolman on night duty to tour the business places of the town was brought to the attention of the Board. The matter was placed on file for future consideration.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to do the following in the Riverhead Lighting District:

Osborn Avenue - Place 1 - 300 C.P. light on Pole #18 and 1 - 100 C.P. light on Pole #14; take present light off Pole #19 and place 1 - 300 C.P. light on Pole #20; take present light off Pole #30 and place 1 - 300 C.P. light on Pole #31.

Pulaski Street - Change present 100 C.P. lights to 300 C.P. lights on Pole #192, Pole on corner of Washington Ave. & Pulaski St., Pole #7, Pole #10 and Pole #19-5. Place 100 C.P. lights on Poles #14 and #18.

Parkway Street - Place 1 - 100 C.P. light on Pole #14.

All the above lights to be placed on eight foot arms. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board present.

The Supervisor's report for the month of October 1948 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, December 1, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.
