

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, December 15, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on December 1, 1948 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Proof of publication of the notice that the Town Board will consider the purchase of machinery for the Highway Department in excess of \$500.00 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Superintendent of Highways be authorized to purchase one Pickup Truck for the amount not to exceed \$1950.00 and one Dump Truck for the sum not to exceed \$6000.00. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Supervisor's report for the month of November 1948 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Harry G. Penny, Secretary of the Riverhead Fire Department together with a report of their annual election held on December 7, 1948 and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that Marion Worth be appointed a temporary Clerk in the office of the Tax Receiver, to serve at the discretion of the Receiver of Taxes, salary fixed at the rate of \$6.00 per day. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Mr. Anthony Wiwihar Jr. addressed the Board and requested permission to use a portion of the land on Harrison Avenue for a parking field.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Town of Riverhead grant to Anthony Wiwihar its right, title and interest, if any, to that portion of school property, formerly known as the Fair Ground property on the east side of Harrison Ave. bounded northerly by property of Gilbert Osborn 400 feet; westerly by

Harrison Avenue 600 feet; southerly by other property belonging to the School District 400 feet and easterly by other property of the School District 600 feet; being a portion of the premises now occupied by the Town of Riverhead by permission Riverhead School Bistrict No 5 upon the condition that the said Anthony Wiwchar Jr. provide minimum liability insurance of \$100,000.00 protecting Riverhead School District No 5 and the Town of Riverhead. The resolution was adpoted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, December 29, 1948 at 9:30 A.M.
