

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, March 20, 1946 at 3:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney was present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on March 6, 1946 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

The matter in regard to the property at the corner of East Main Street and McDermott Ave. was discussed as a possible parking field. It was decided that the Town Board and the Supt. of Highways inspect the proposed property in order to ascertain the approximate cost of putting it into proper condition.

Justice Yousik offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Warner,

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverhead on June 24th, 1944, entered into a certain lease with Joseph Greenberg of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, for the rental of a certain property located on the south side of East Main Street in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, for a term of two years, and

WHEREAS, the said lease will expire on the 24th day of June, 1946, and that said Joseph Greenberg has requested that the term of said lease be terminated and cancelled, and

WHEREAS, the said Joseph Greenberg has agreed to pay back to the Town of Riverhead the entire rental on said premises from December 1, 1945 (being the amount of the taxes on said premises for the taxable year 1945-46), now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the aforementioned lease entered into on the 24th day of June, 1944 be and the same hereby is cancelled upon repayment to the Town of the 1945-46 taxes, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead execute and deliver on behalf of the Town of Riverhead all necessary papers and agreements to carry in effect the above mentioned resolution. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from the Suffolk County Civil Service Commission advising the Board that the Commission had decided to hold examinations for Police Patrolmen on or about May 25th, 1946. The communication was ordered placed on file

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the following bonds be approved as to form, manner of execution and the sufficiency of the surety:

Edward M. Lockwood as Justice of the Peace in the amount of \$1000.00. No 357863, Glens Falls Indemnity Co.

Austin H. Warner as Justice of the Peace in the amount of \$1000.00 .No 2105048, Fidelity & Casualty Co.

The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Forrest G. Downs, Receiver of Taxes submitted a report of the amount of taxes received as of March 15, 1946 and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Warner it was Resolved that Chief of Police, John Doscinski be authorized to attend a School of Law Enforcement Administration, sponsored by the New York State Sheriffs Association and the New York State Association of Chiefs of Police to be held at New York City April 22 through April 26, 1946 and that all of his necessary expenses be paid. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, April 3, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.
