

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 25, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on September 11, 1946 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Riverhead Garden Club in regard to the care and the maintenance of the street trees in the Town of Riverhead and urged that an appropriation of \$1000.00 be put into the budget for the ensuing year for this purpose. The communication was ordered placed on file.

Mr. William J. Hattrick, Special Attorney to/Board made a report on the progress of the appeal by the Town of Riverhead to the New York State Tax Commission from the reports of the Suffolk County Equalization Committee for the years 1944 and 1945. He also advised the Board that a meeting will be held on this matter on next Tuesday, October 1, 1946 at which time the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, the County Equalization Board and the County Attorney will meet with ~~the~~ representatives of the Town of Riverhead and himself to discuss an equitable solution.

The Civil Service Eligible List for the positions of Police Patrolmen in the Town of Riverhead was submitted to the Board.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Warner it was RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be authorized to canvass the names on the Civil Service eligible list for the positions of Police Patrolmen at a salary of \$2200.00 per annum. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Warner it was RESOLVED THAT the appointments of A. John Doscinski, Chief of Town Police, O. Halsey Corwin, George W. Cooper, Robert G. Leonard, Harold M. Bowden, Chester J. Kowalsky, John R. McGoey and Stephen J. Grodski, Police Patrolmen be and they hereby are terminated, effective as of October 15, 1946 at 12 o'clock midnight. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby grant to the Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead the power and authority to construct a sidewalk on the northerly side of State Highway #25, from Sta. 120-00

(East side of Herrick Lane) to Sta. 155-37 (Riverhead-Southold Town Line) as shown on plans prepared by Daniel R. Young, March 3, 1945, entitled New York State Postwar Planning Commission, Serial No. 1944, Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, Town-wide Sidewalk Project, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the State of New York and/or its agents, servants and employees shall not be liable for injuries to persons and/or property, not caused by the State of New York, its agents, servants or employees, which may occur during the repairing and/or building by the Riverhead Town Superintendent of Highways of the aforesaid sidewalk. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to borrow the sum of \$4585.00 on Tax Anticipation Notes for the purpose of paying the actual expenses for snow removal. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that there shall be no parking on the East side of Marcy Avenue from 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. ^{From the Rail Road to Putaski St.} on week-days, and that signs be placed there to that effect. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, October 2, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.
