

Minutes of the meeting of the Town Board, held in the Town Office, October 31, 1930 following the Budget Hearing.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the salary of the Receiver of Taxes of the Town of Riverhead be and the same is hereby fixed at \$1800.00 per year effective January 1, 1931.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the Superintendent of Highways be and he hereby is authorized to purchase two 1 Ton International Dump Trucks at a cost of \$1236.40 each, trading in two dump trucks for which \$350.00 will be allowed to apply on the purchase price.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, November 12, 1930 at 2 P.M.
