On motion made seconded and carried Justice Robert Burnside was appointed temporary chairman of this meeting.

The minutes of the regular meeting held February 13th, 1924 were read and on motion adopted.

The minutes of the Special meeting held February 19th, 1924 were read and on motion adopted.

Mr. E.E. Smith of Calverton addressed the board relative to the concrete road to be built on Edwards Avenue and requested that this road be started first.

On motion made seconded and carried the Town Board recommended that both sections of the concrete roads to be built be started as soon as possible and that Edwards Avenue be started and completed first.


On motion made seconded and carried the following resolution was duly adopted:-

Resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$1600.00 dollars to pay audited bills for the month of March, 1924.

On motion made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Special Constable appointed March 19th, 1924 be paid \$.82½ cts. per hour for an eight hour day and allowed \$ 2.00 per day expenses for his motorcycle.

It was decided to hold the next meeting of this board on Thursday April 3rd, 1924 at 7-30 P.M.
