Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the board consent to the applications for and the order laying out a highway from Riverside Drive to the Peconic River to be known as Corwell Avenue.

The Superintendent of Highways stated that the receiver for the Mc Dermott Farm & Supply Co. was about to bring an action against the town for the recovery of the purchase price of tile upon which a lien had been filed Edward E. Buhler Company for \$ 522.15.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Town employ counsel for the defense of any action that might be brought thereupon.

Justice Raymond H. Vail, the committee appointed to confer with the Southampton Town Board for the purpose of obtaining its cooperation in the adoption and enforcement of parking regulations similar to those of this town for the regulation of parking on Peconic Avenue in the Town of Southampton, reported that the Southampton Town Board had agreed to adopt the suggestions and request.

On motion duly made seconded and carried Town Clerk was directed to communicate with the Southampton Town Board thanking them for their action.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the Board adjourned to meet at the Town Office on May 28th, 1924 at 2-00 P.M.
