

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's office, Monday, August 11th, 1924. *at 8-00 P. M.*

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

The Clerk read a petition of nine taxpayers, filed in the Town Clerk's office on August 11, 1924, praying for the extension of Lighting District No. 1, so as to include property fronting on both sides of Roanoke Avenue as far north as Middle Road.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the said petition was referred to a committee consisting of Justices Raymond H. Vail and Dwight T. Corwin, and said committee was instructed to confer with taxpayers and out line a proposed extension of said district to include property within the bounds of Raynor, Osborn Avenues, Middle Road, and Northville Turnpike.


On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that Lorimer M. Raynor be, and he hereby is appointed attendance officer for all School Districts in the town, except such as are wholly or partly included within the Village of Sound Avenue.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the supervisor and town clerk be, and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$3500.00 and place the same to the credit of the Highway Fund Item No. 1, for the purpose of extraordinary repairs in oiling the following highways:- Middle Island Road, River Road, Northville Turnpike and Manor Lane.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the Town Clerk was instructed to request the County Engineer to prepare and present the proper supplemental agreement for such extraordinary repairs.

The vote by roll call upon each of the two motions immediately preceding was as follows:- Yes 7, No. 0.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried the Board adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office on August 13th, 1924 at 8 P. M.
