

Minutes of the Biennial Town Meeting of the town of Riverhead held in the Auditorium Tuesday, April 6, 1909 at 12 o'clock noon.

Meeting called to order by Town Clerk Hagen and on motion Justice F. H. Tuthill was made Chairman of the meeting.

On motion the following resolutions were adopted:

Resolved, That there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1909-10 the sum of \$500 for the Board of Health.

Resolved, That there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1909-10 the sum of \$500 for the support of the town poor.

Resolved, That there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1909-10 the sum of \$500 for Contingent Expenses.

Resolved, That there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1909-10 the sum of \$50 for the proper observance of Memorial Day, said sum to be paid to the Commander of Henry A. Barnum Post, G. A. R.

~~Resolved, That there be inserted in the Tax Levy~~

Resolved, That the sum of \$50 be donated to St. Peters' Hospital, the same to be taken from the Dog Fund.

On motion a resolution was adopted to employ counsel other than the Town Counsel, to take steps to open Farragut Avenue as nothing has been done in regard to the resolution passed at the last Town Meeting.
