Supervisor-elect George F. Homan was present and presented his bond of \$5000, which on motion was approved and accepted.

Supervisor Howell turned over his books to his successor, who assumed the chair.

The books showed balances on hand as follows:

On motion the sum of \$150 was appropriated to the


use of the Overseer of the Poor, the same to be taken from the Dog Fund.

On motion the matter of appointing a Town Board of Audit was alid over until the next meeting of the Board.

Justice Hildreth presented his undertaking and on motion same approved.

On motion the Town Board fixed Friday as the day to inspect the town highways, prior to entering into an agreement for the apportionment of the Highway Monies.
