

Minutes of a special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, held on the 2nd day of September, 1924, at the Town Clerk's office in said town, at 1 o'clock P.M.

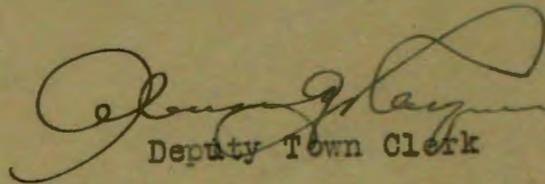
On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was resolved that the Town Board co-operate with the said committee and publish a request that the day be observed throughout the town and that places of business be closed on said day between the hours of 3;30 and 5;30 P.M.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried Justices Burnside and Corwin were appointed a committee to prepare such notice and to represent the Board at meetings of the Military or Citizens committee.

The general operation of the Traffic Regulations at present were discussed and several proposed amendments suggested. On motion duly made, seconded and carried the matter was referred to the Committee heretofore appointed

for consideration and recommendation in the matter.
