

Minutes of a joint meeting of the Town Board and Highway Commissioner of the town of Riverhead held in the office of Justice Hildreth Wednesday, April 28, 1909.

Meeting called for the purpose of apportioning the Highway Monies among the several roads of the town.

An agreement was entered into and a copy filed in the office of the Town Clerk.

On motion the following resolution was adopted:

Resolved, That the Supervisor and Highway Commissioner be appointed a committee to confer with the Town Counsel as to the best means of widening and defining the Main highway from Roanoke Avenue to the East Town Line, also Sound Avenue.

On motion the Highway Commissioner was authorized to use tile for private driveways in the town.

Stanley Rutger appeared before the Board and requested that a permit be granted him to lay down a cement sidewalk in front of his barber shop on Peconic Avenue. On motion the request was granted.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
