WHEREAS, this Town Board is anxious to protect the safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Riverhead, and

WHEREAS, the review of the operating facilities proposed by Suffolk County is in the best interest of the Town of Riverhead,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that this Town Board fully supports the actions of Suffolk County in proposing a complete inspection of the Shoreham Nuclear PowerPlant facilities, such investigation to be conducted by Suffolk County, and be it further


RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the County Executive for Suffolk County.
