RESOLUTIONS191 AUTHORIZES AND MAKES APPLICATION TO THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO EXTEND WATER MAINS INTO CONTAMINATED AREAS

Councilman Prusinowski offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Councilman Lombardi.

WHEREAS, the County of Suffolk has authorized financial assistance for the extension of water mains to homeowners whose water supply is contaminated by nitrates and other contaminants rendering their water undrinkable;

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverhead has previously embarked upon a vigorous program for water main extensions for the purpose of providing public water from the Riverhead Water District to areas of contamination which have been identified within the Town of Riverhead; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to memorialize the extensions as previously approved by the Town Board, which are currently pending final State approval and construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead reaffirms its policy to provide safe drinking water from the Riverhead Water District to contaminated areas from the following extensions:

1. Extension #26, known as Fresh Pond Landing, the cost to be borne for those within the extension is \$760,000.00; the contribution of the District as a whole is \$190,000.00;

2. Extension #32J, known as Jamesport, the cost to be borne by those within the extension is \$2,513,000.00; the contribution of the District as a whole is \$356,000.00;

3. Extension #33, known as Wildwood, the cost to be borne by those within the extension is \$634,000.00; Town aid (Federal Funds) of \$240,000.00; the contribution of the District as a whole is \$218,000.00;

4. Extension #34, known as Central Aquebogue, the cost to be borne by those within the extension is \$700,000.00; the contribution of the District as a whole is \$175,000.00;

5. Extension #35, known as Wading River, the cost to be borne by those within the extension is \$2,722,000.00; the contribution of the District as a whole is \$680,000.00;

and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead hereby expresses its appreciation to the County of Suffolk for its assistance in procuring safe drinking water for the residents of the Town of Riverhead.

The vote, Boschetti, absent, Lombardi, Yes, Prusinowski, Yes, Pike, absent, and Janoski, Yes.

The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.
