


WAIVER OF NOTICE AND CONSENT  
OF SPECIAL MEETING





The following is a summary of the minutes of the Special Town Board Meeting held by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead at Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York on Monday, November 20, 2017 at 3:00 p.m.

**PRESENT**

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The Supervisor opened the special town board meeting at 3:00 P.M. with the pledge of allegiance. One time sensitive resolution was considered for adoption.

**Resolution #864**

Councilwoman Giglio: “Adopts Town of Riverhead 2018 Annual Budget. So moved”

Councilman Hubbard: “and seconded”

Supervisor Walter: “Moved and seconded. Vote please.”

**The Vote:** “Hubbard, yes; Giglio”

Councilwoman Giglio: “No, I don’t agree with the Department Head raises in the budget. I think that I voted no for the resolution on December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016, tying them to the CSEA contract. I think that they should have individual management contracts and for that reason and others, like salaries, which changes can be made after the first of the year before we adopt the salary schedules. But, because of the raises for the Department Heads and other raises that are in the budget, I’m voting no”

Vote Continued: “Wooten”

Councilman Wooten: “I can understand the reasoning that went behind the Department Heads because of favoritism that sometimes got played. I understand it was something that should be common practice. But, so I understand why that was instituted, and that can always be looked at in the future. I vote yes”

Vote Continued: “Dunleavy”

Councilman Dunleavy: “We’re one of the lowest economic towns in Suffolk County and we have the second highest paid Supervisor in the County”

Supervisor Walter: “Damn well deserved I might add”

Councilman Dunleavy: “I wanted to lower the Supervisors salary to a culpable to the rest of the East End and Islip Supervisors but I don’t know if I have enough votes”

Supervisor Walter: “You don’t have a resolution”

Councilman Dunleavy: “I know, so I’m going to vote no”

Vote Continued: “Walter”

Supervisor Walter: “Absolutely yes. It’s a great budget

Diane Wilhelm: “Resolution adopted.”

Supervisor Walter: “That concludes the business. Can I have a motion to adjourn?”

Councilman Dunleavy: “I make a motion that we adjourn”

Supervisor Walter: “seconded. All in favor, aye? Opposed? Abstentions? Motion carries. We are adjourned”
