RESOLUTIONS Continued:#478 AUTHORIZES TOWN ATTORNEY TO REPRESENT TOWN OF RIVERHEAD IN LITIGATION

WHEREAS, it is necessary to institute proceedings in the Supreme Court of the County of Suffolk against Lebanon Chemical Corp. for storage of hazardous chemicals on their property located in Jamesport, New York; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary for the Town Attorney to represent the Town of Riverhead and to institute said proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Town Attorney be and is hereby authorized to represent the Town of Riverhead and bring suit against Lebanon Chemical Corp. to enjoin their use of their premises at Jamesport and for such other and further relief as necessary.

#479 AUTHORIZES SUPERVISOR TO REQUEST TRANSPORTATION TRAFFIC STUDY
