

Minutes of an Adjourned Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall, Riverhead, New York, on Tuesday, April 25, 1978 at 4:00 P.M.

Supervisor Smith called the meeting to order at 4:00 P.M.

RESOLUTIONS#205 AUTHORIZE TOWN CLERK TO PUBLICIZE HUD PUBLIC HEARINGS

Councilman Menendez offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Young.

WHEREAS, A letter dated April 11, 1978 from the Region II Office of the Department of Housing & Urban Development, and Notice and Regulations, published in the Federal Register on March 1, 1978, the Town of Riverhead is entitled to apply to the Department of Housing & Urban Development for participation in the "Small Cities Program" of the Housing & Community Development Act of 1977, and

WHEREAS, Public Hearings are necessary to comply with requirements for the Town of Riverhead to apply,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead is hereby authorized to publicize and post the public notice that on May 2, 1978, at 8:15 P.M., at the Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, N.Y., the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead will hear all those interested in suggesting possible programs of work for a "Small Cities" application, and having heard such suggestions, the Town Board must prepare a tentative application, which is the subject of a further public hearing, hence

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead is hereby also authorized to publicize and post the public notice that, on May 9, 1978 at 7:45 P.M., at the Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, N.Y., the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead will hold a special Town Board Meeting and a public hearing on a tentative application for a "Small Cities" grant. All persons wishing to be heard on said application should appear at the above-stated time and place.

#206 DESIGNATING "NEWSDAY" OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF TOWN

WHEREAS, A special permit was granted on April 4, 1978 to construct a one-family residence in a business zone, located on Maple Street, Riverhead; with the condition that the tree on the property be preserved,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, That the Town Board affirms our prior condition for that permit and direct the applicants to re-design the house in such a manner to preserve the tree.
