RESOLUTIONS

Councilman Menendez offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Lombardi.

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Menendez.

RESOLVED, That the revised Bond of Iron Pier Woods be and the same hereby is approved in the annexed form:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That WE, IRON PIER WOODS, a PARTNERSHIP OF WILLIAM W. ESSEKS, ROBERT L. TOOKER, MARGARET W. TOOKER and JAMES F. REEVE of 108 East Main Street, Riverhead, New York, as Principal and the REPUBLIC INSURANCE COMPANY, a Texas Corporation authorized to do business in the State of New York, having an office and place of business at 129 Fulton Street, New York, New York as Surety are held and firmly bound unto the TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, SUFFOLK COUNTY, NEW YORK AS OBLIGEE in the sum of FORTY NINE THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$49,000.00) DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States of America to be paid to the said Obligee for which payment well and truly to be made, the Principal, and the Surety bind themselves, their successors and assigns jointly and severally firmly by these presents.

WHEREAS, THE Principal has made application to the Planning Board of the Town of Riverhead for approval and filing of subdivision map entitled "Iron Pier Woods" situated in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York dated and revised May 6, 1976 prepared by Howard W. Young, Riverhead, New York and;

WHEREAS, The Principal is required by the Obligee to construct and faithfully complete all improvements shown on said subdivision map known as "Iron Pier Woods" and as required by the Riverhead Town Planning Board resolution of May 6, 1976 in accordance with the construction specifications in the Rules and Regulations for the dedication of a public highway in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York as is more fully described in the resolution of the Planning Board made the 6th day of May 1976 and;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if the Principal shall well and truly at its own cost and expense, within two (2) years from the date, subject to renewal by the Town Board, hereof construct roads, highways, curbs, drainage systems, road surfacing and all other required improvements in the

subdivision known as Iron Pier Woods as said work is more fully described in the aforesaid resolution of the Planning Board of the Town of Riverhead, made May 6, 1976 and as shown on said subdivision map known as "Iron Pier Woods" dated May 6, 1976 and all in accordance with the construction specifications and rules and regulations of the Town of Riverhead, and shall in addition procure a release of this Bond from the Riverhead Town Planning Board, the Riverhead Town Board and the Riverhead Town Highway Superintendent, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

The vote, Lombardi, Yes, Tomlinson, Yes, Menendez, Yes, Young, Yes, and Smith, Yes.

The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Councilman Young offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Lombardi.

RESOLVED, That pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Town Law and the General Municipal Law, by reason of the fact that the purchase of snow plow blades of different sizes and descriptions results in the alteration and change of said blades and additional time and construction costs in the Highway Department, that the same should be standardized as "Good Road Plows" and that bid forms shall be prepared therefor and bids sought on said Plow Blades.

The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

Councilwoman Tomlinson offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Menendez.

RESOLVED, That Robert Leonard be and hereby is authorized to attend the Magistrates' Conference at Stevensville, New York, on September 19, 20, 21 and 22, 1976, and that all necessary expenses therefor be paid out of the Town Justices' Budget.

Councilwoman Tomlinson offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Lombardi.

RESOLVED, That the members of the Planning Board, Mrs. Jane Stromski, Peter S. Danowski, Jr., Esq., and the Zoning Board of Appeals be and they are hereby authorized to attend the Annual Planning and Zoning Institute to be held October 10, 11 and 12, 1976, at Monticello, New York, and that their expenses therefor be paid out of their respective budgets.
