

BETWEEN

THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, a municipal corporation with offices at 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, hereinafter referred to as "**TOWN**" and **KAISER MAINTENANCE**, P.O. Box 118, Jamesport, New York, hereinafter referred to as "**CONTRACTOR**".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Town, in connection with its municipal operations, requires services consisting of the following: the application of pesticides by a New York State DEC Certified Pesticide Applicator; and

WHEREAS, the contractor is willing to provide the following services to the Town:

Description of services: Application of pesticides, as more fully described in Schedule "A" annexed and made part hereof.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED, by the Town and Contractor as follows:

1. That Contractor shall provide and fully perform to the Town's satisfaction the aforementioned services to the Town as described in Schedule "A".
2. In return for Contractor's services, the Town shall pay Contractor not later than forty five (45) days after the Contractor provides the services and complies with the procedures described herein. That sum shall be payable after the Contractor performs the services described for the Town and after contractor has filed with the Town of Riverhead, vouchers and any other documents reasonably required for payment.

3. Pursuant to General Municipal Law § 109, this contract may not be assigned, assigned, transferred, conveyed, sublet or otherwise disposed of by the Contractor without previous written consent of the Town.

4. The Town agrees, except where Contractor is negligent, to fully indemnify, save and hold harmless the Contractor and all of its officers, agents and employees from and against any and all liability of any type whatsoever including but not limited to any and all damages, expenses, causes of action, lawsuits, claims, penalties, fines, assessments or judgments relating to, arising out of or occurring in connection with the within agreement.

5. The Town shall, at its own cost and expense, defend any and all actions or suits which may be brought against the Contractor or any of its officers, agents or employees or in which the Town or said officers, agents or employees may be impleaded with others upon any such above-mentioned claim. The Town shall satisfy, pay and discharge any and all judgments that may be recovered against the Contractor or any of its officers, agents or employees in any such suits or actions which may be brought against the Contractor or any of its officers, agents or employees or in which the Contractor or any of its officers, agents or employees may be impleaded with others.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

During the first five (5) days the dog may be redeemed by its owner, provided that such owner produces proof that the dog has been licensed and has been identified pursuant to the provisions of Article 7 of the New York State Agriculture and Markets Law, as well as paying ~~any fees imposed by this chapter, including the redemption fees imposed by the Agriculture and Markets Law § 118.~~ After a period of five (5) days, such unidentified dog shall be available for adoption. the following impoundment fees:

1. twenty dollars (\$20.) for the first impoundment of any dog owned by that person;
2. thirty dollars (\$30.) for the first twenty-four (24) hours or part thereof and three dollars (\$3.) for each additional twenty-four (24) hours or part thereof for the second impoundment, within one year of the first impoundment, of any dog owned by that person;
3. fifty dollars (\$50.) for the first twenty-four (24) hours or part thereof and five dollars (\$5.) for each additional twenty-four (24) hours or part thereof for the third and subsequent impoundments, within one year of the first impoundment, of any dog owned by that person.

After a period of five (5) days, such unidentified dog shall be available for adoption.

B. Identified dogs. Promptly upon seizure of any identified dog, the owner of record of such dog shall be notified personally or by the Town Clerk by certified mail, return receipt requested, of the facts of seizure and the procedure for redemption. If notification is personally given, such dog shall be held for a minimum period of ten (10) days after the day of notice, during which period the dog may be redeemed by the owner upon producing proof of license for such dog and the payment of any fees imposed by this chapter. If such notification is made by mail, such dog shall be held for a minimum period of twelve (12) days from the date of mailing, during which period the dog may be redeemed by the owner upon producing proof of license for such dog and the payment of any fees imposed by this chapter, including the redemption fees imposed by the

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverhead (the "Town"), has distributed a Request for Proposals with respect to the lease or sale of a parcel of real property (the "Site"), constituting approximately 3.2 acres located on East Main Street and owned by the Town of Riverhead Community Development Agency (the "Agency"), and the redevelopment of the Site as an aquarium or similar traffic generator facility; and

WHEREAS, in response to such Request for Proposals, two proposals were received, one from the Atlantic Coast Aquarium and one from the Atlantis Seaquarium of Long Island; and

WHEREAS, both the Agency and the Town have considered and evaluated both submitted proposals, have asked for clarification from each proposer and have received clarifications from each proposer; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department of the Town has been asked to review each proposal and to advise the Town Board with respect to certain environmental consequences of each proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department of the Town, by Memorandum dated February 9, 1998, has advised the Town Board that the project proposed in the Atlantic Coast Aquarium proposal is clearly in conformance with the Town's Urban Renewal Plan for the Central

Business District and that the scope of the proposed project for all impact parameters (water resources, terrestrial and aquatic ecology, transportation, land use, community services and cultural resources) is less than the level of those impacts initially measured in the environmental review process of the special permit and site plan petition of the former Okeanos Aquarium previously undertaken with respect to the Site and identified by the findings statement associated with the approval of the former Okeanos petition relating to the Okeanos Aquarium project; and

WHEREAS, said Planning Department by said Memorandum has further advised the Town Board that the Atlantis Seaquarium of Long Island proposed project scope demonstrably exceeds the level of impacts to the natural and social environment initially measured for the Site in the environmental analysis conducted for the Okeanos Aquarium project and the special permit and site plan petition relating thereto, that specific environmental impacts exceeding those previously identified and mitigated include impacts associated with disturbance within tidal wetland areas, impacts upon water resources, impacts upon terrestrial and aquatic ecology, impacts upon transportation networks, impacts upon land use and zoning, impacts upon community services and impacts upon cultural resources; and

Section 2. The Agency, upon completion of said negotiations and preparation of said agreements and documents, is authorized and directed to provide all such agreements and documents to this Town Board together with a recommendation to this Town Board as to whether the Agency should designate the Atlantic Coast Aquarium a "sponsor" of such project.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

This ANNUAL WATER SUPPLY STATEMENT is provided in compliance with Title III Sections 1150-1153 of the New York State Public Health Law. This statement provides basic information relative to the current status of the Water Quantity, Water Quality and Water Conservation of the Riverhead Water District. A summary of the 1997 laboratory testing results from the distribution system and a review of water conservation measures available to the District's consumers are also provided.

The source of water for the District is groundwater from the Glacial and Magothy aquifers beneath Long Island. Generally, the water quality of the aquifers is good to excellent, although there are localized areas of contamination and the pH of the untreated water is low (acidic). The water obtained from the District's active wells meets all water quality criteria established by Federal and State agencies.

The approximate population served by the Riverhead Water District during 1997 was 34,000. The total amount of water withdrawn from the aquifer in 1997 was 1,484,149,000 gallons, of which approximately 90.75 percent was billed directly to consumers at a rate of \$10.90 per quarter for the first 7,000 gallons and \$1.00 per additional 1,000 gallons thereafter.

WATER QUALITY DATA

During 1997, a total of 300 bacteriological samples were taken from the distribution system of the Riverhead Water District. There were no violations of the requirements of Part 5 of the Sanitary Code as it relates to microbiological water quality.

During 1997 the District continued conducting a special investigation of the incidence of lead and copper leaching from household plumbing fixtures in accordance with USEPA regulations. This study consisted of samples taken from thirty (30) qualified homes throughout the community. None of the samples exceeded the "action level" for lead or copper. Therefore, the District will continue with its present pH adjustment. A summary of the test results and applicable action level is as follows:

*The EPA regulation specifies an action level for lead and copper levels at the 90th percentile of samples taken.

The program results were in compliance with the USEPA's action level criteria. Therefore, the District will continue with its present pH adjustment program.

The Riverhead Water District provides two types of treatment at all wells to improve the quality of the water pumped prior to distribution to the consumer. The pH of the pumped water is adjusted upward to reduce the corrosive action between water and water mains and in-house plumbing by the addition of lime. The pumped water is also chlorinated to a minimum chlorine residual of 0.2 mg/l to protect against the growth of bacteria within the distribution system. The Riverhead Water District also adds iron sequestering agents to all of its wells as part of the District's overall water treatment program to supplement corrosion control and to maintain iron in the soluble state to minimize water stains. The water from Well No. 3 is also treated by a granular activated carbon filter to remove any volatile organic or gasoline additive products.

New York State law now requires all Public Water Suppliers to notify their consumers about the risks of cryptosporidiosis and giardiasis. Cryptosporidiosis and giardiasis are intestinal illnesses caused by microscopic parasites. While these parasites have been known to be transmitted through drinking water, there have been no known outbreaks of giardiasis or cryptosporidiosis linked to the water supply in Nassau and Suffolk Counties. Most cases of giardiasis in Nassau and Suffolk Counties are a result of person to person transmission and have been associated with travel outside of Nassau and Suffolk or from direct contact with people who have traveled.

Cryptosporidiosis can be very serious for people with weak immune systems, such as transplant patients or individuals receiving chemotherapy or dialysis and people with Crohn's disease or HIV infection. Individuals who think they may have been exposed to giardiasis or cryptosporidiosis should contact their health care providers immediately. People with weakened immune systems should discuss with their health care providers the need to take extra precautions such as boiling water.

Should you have any questions concerning cryptosporidiosis or giardiasis, you may contact the Suffolk County Department of Health Services.

In 1997, the Riverhead Water District continued to implement a water conservation program in order to minimize any unnecessary water use. The pumpage for 1997 was 18.7 percent higher than in 1996. This increase can most likely be attributed to the relatively hot/dry summer weather of 1997.

The Riverhead Water District has continued to implement a water conservation program since 1991. Residents of the District can also implement water conservation measures such as retrofitting plumbing fixtures with flow restrictors, modifying automatic lawn sprinklers to include rain sensors, repairing leaks in the home, installing water conservation fixtures/appliances and maintaining a daily awareness of water conservation in their personal habits. Besides protecting the limited underground water supply, water conservation will produce a cost savings to the consumer in terms of both water and energy bills due to the use of hot water.

The following are the analytical testing results for 1997 for those constituents required to be tested under Part 5 of the State Sanitary Code for distribution locations. Where more than one analysis per year was conducted for a specific constituent, the range of results, from highest to lowest, during the reporting period is listed. The applicable State guideline, standard or maximum contaminant level (if available) for each constituent is listed.

Copies of this Annual Water Supply Statement and a Supplemental Data Package, which includes the water quality data for each well utilized during 1997, are available at the Riverhead Water District office located at 1035 Pulaski Street, Riverhead, New York and the Riverhead Public Library.
