PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead adopted an amendment to Chapter 108, entitled, "Zoning", of the Riverhead Town Code at its regular meeting held on May 5, 1998, as follows:

Article XXXX  
INDUSTRIAL C DISTRICT (TOURIST DESTINATION)

§108-207. Purpose

It is the purpose of this article to provide for tourist destination and regional recreational commercial land uses upon those lands which are appropriate due to accessibility to transportation networks including arterial roadways, rail transportation and airport facilities. Certain areas within Industrial C District will be the zoning use district regulating the real property identified as a TDR Receiving Area pursuant to the Town of Riverhead Master Plan and its amendments as the Town Board may adopt from time to time.

§108-208. Uses.

In the Industrial C District no building, structure or premises shall be used or arranged or designated to be used, and no building or structure should be hereafter erected, reconstructed or altered, unless otherwise provided in this chapter except for the following permitted or specially permitted uses and their customary accessory uses:

A. Permitted Uses:

1. Agriculture
2. Greenhouse, Plant Nursery and Garden Center
3. Dog and Horse Training
4. Inns
5. Offices
6. Golf Courses, Golf Clubs
7. Cemetery
8. Warehouses
9. Museums, Galleries

B. Except as otherwise provided herein, the following shall be special permit uses:

1. Sports Arena, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board
2. Hotels, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board
3. Wholesale Business (Non-nuisance), providing the sale of commodities to retailers, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board
4. Tavern, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board

5. Restaurant; excluding outdoor counter service, or drive-in curb establishments, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board
6. Resorts, convention and conference center, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board
7. Theme Attractions, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board
8. Film Production Studios, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board
9. Indoor Recreational Facilities, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board
10. Vocational School, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board
11. Assembly Hall, when authorized by special permit of the Town Board

C. Accessory Uses. Accessory uses shall include any of those uses customarily incidental to any of the permitted or specially permitted uses included herein when located on the same lot. Accessory uses specifically allowed include but are not limited to the following:

1. Private garages, off street parking areas, or loading areas
2. Fully enclosed storage areas
3. Maintenance and utility facilities
4. Playground, recreational facilities
5. Transportation facilities

**§108-209. General Lot Yard and Building Requirements.**

- A. The minimum lot area shall be 80,000 square feet.
- B. The minimum lot width shall be 300 feet.
- C. The maximum building area shall be 35%.
- D. The minimum front yard shall be 100 feet. Parking is restricted from development within the front yard.
- E. The minimum side yard shall be 75 feet.
- F. The maximum building height shall be 35 feet;
- G. The minimum rear yard shall be 75 feet.
- H. The minimum side yard width abutting a side street shall be 100 feet.

**§108-210. Additional Development Standards.**

- A. The development of real property involving transferred development credits shall increase the maximum sanitary wastewater flow to a maximum of 600 gallons per day per acre, pursuant to Article 6 of the Suffolk County Sanitary Code. Development credits shall be transferred pursuant to Chapter 95A of the Town Code and §108-68 of the Zoning Ordinance as may be amended from time to time.
- B. Pursuant to Articles XX and XXVI of the Riverhead Town Zoning Ordinance, site plan review of all development is required. In the consideration of a site plan the Town Board shall require the following:
  1. Landscaped area of minimum of 25% of the total site.
  2. In parking areas greater than 10,000 square feet, landscaped areas shall be employed to interrupt asphalt areas at a rate of 30 square feet per parking space.
- C. To the greatest extent practical, the subdivision of real property within the Industrial C Zoning Use District shall employ the creation of blocks which may be further

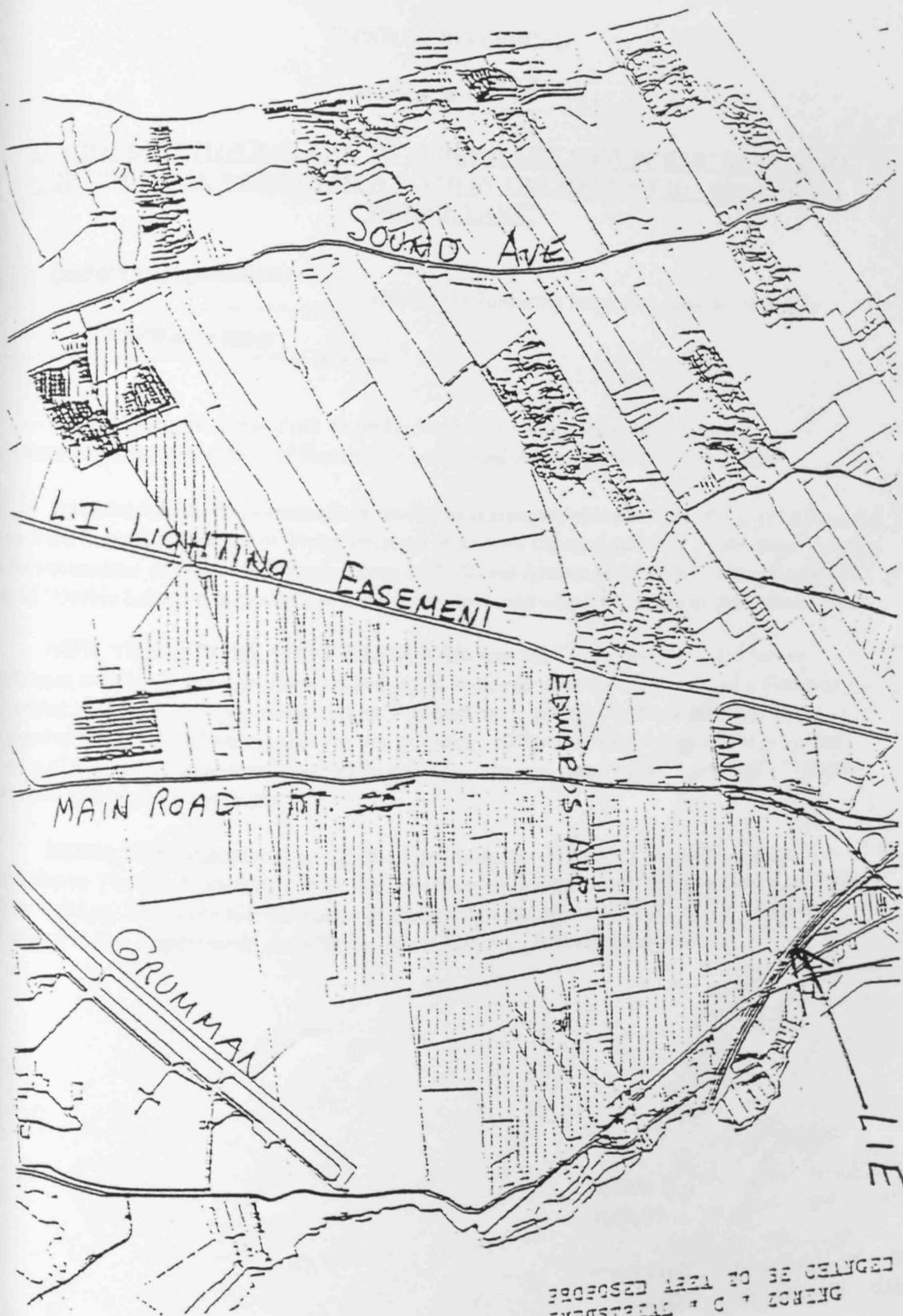

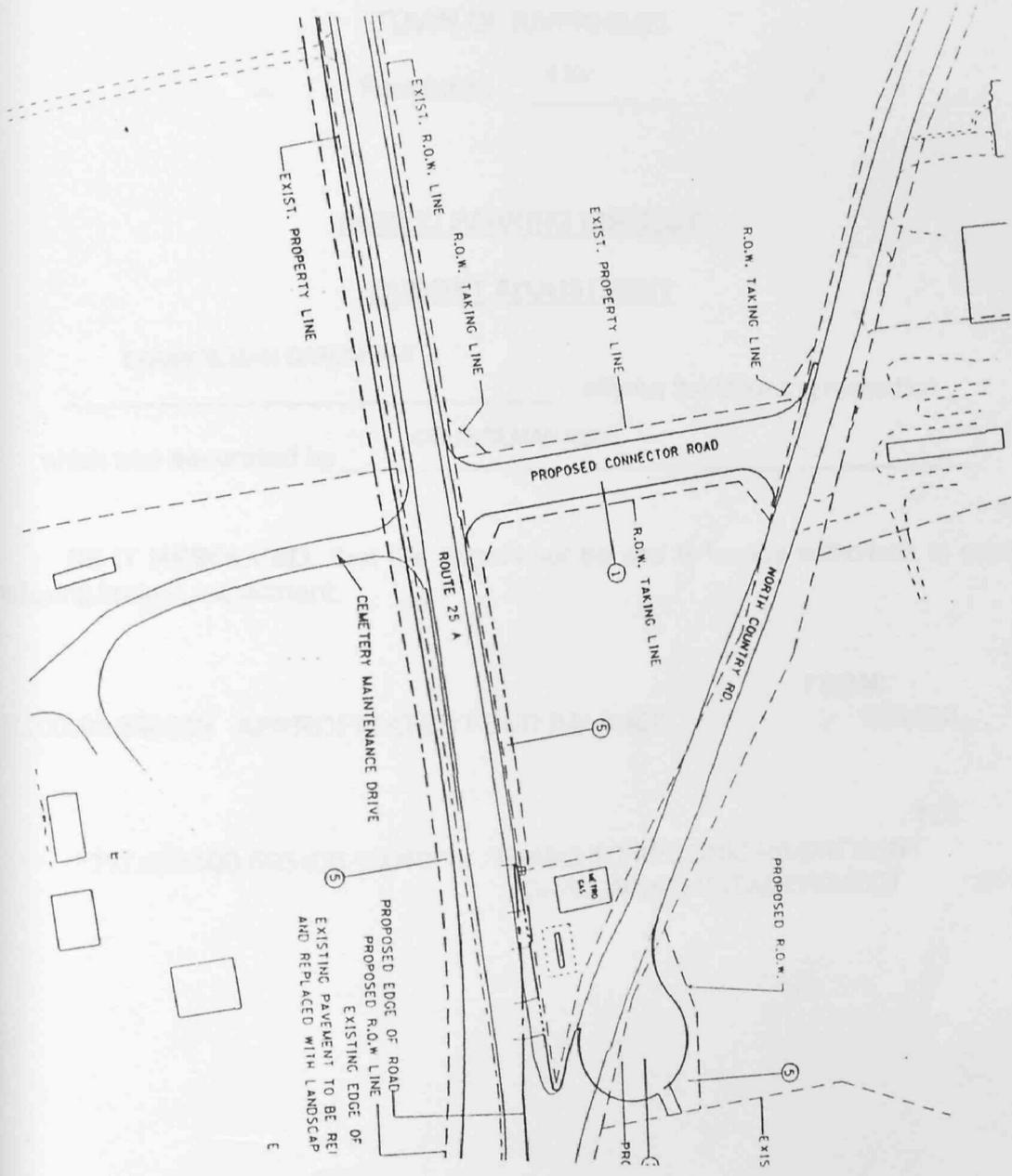

## AGREEMENT

Agreement by and between the Town of Riverhead and John Kalba, Sr.

1. The disciplinary charges dated March 23, 1998 will be withdrawn upon Kalba's timely and complete performance of his duties and obligations pursuant to this Agreement.

2. Kalba shall execute and tender to the Town Supervisor with the execution of this Agreement his irrevocable letter of resignation from the Town retirement purposes effective August 28, 1998.

3. Kalba's suspension without pay shall be continued until August 28, 1998, the effective date of his resignation for retirement purposes. However, effective May 5, 1998, or the day following the meeting at which the Town Board acts upon this Agreement, whichever comes first, Kalba shall become entitled to utilize any or all of his leave accruals earned as of this date.

4. The Town shall continue to provide Kalba with his present health, dental and optical benefit(s), if any, until October 31, 1998, unless and except to the extent that they are changed on a unit-wide level. Kalba's entitlement, if any, to the continuation of any or all of those benefits after October 31, 1998 and during his retirement shall be governed by the CSEA contract and applicable laws, rules, regulations and Town policies and procedures.

5. Kalba shall earn no further sick, personal, vacation or other leave time beyond that to which he was entitled as of this date.

6. Kalba shall be paid at the time of his resignation from employment with the Town for those accrued unused vacation and sick days, minus all applicable withholdings, to which he is entitled by and pursuant to the CSEA collective bargaining agreement.

7. Upon request from any future or prospective employers, the Town shall only provide the attached letter of reference on Mr. Kalba's behalf. No further information shall be provided.

8. By not later than April 29, 1998, Kalba shall return to Superintendent of Highways any and all equipment, keys, documents and/or other Town property not previously returned to the Town and still in his possession. The Town shall afford Mr. Kalba the opportunity to remove and take possession of his personal effects still on Town property.

9. Upon his resignation from employment with the Town, Kalba agrees that he shall have no right of employment in any position with the Town and hereby waives this right to the extent it may otherwise exist.

10. Kalba hereby releases the Town, the members of the Town Board, the Town's officers, agents, employees, attorneys and representatives, their predecessors and successors, heirs and assigns, and all persons acting by, through, under or in concert with any of the above ("the Releasees"), from any and all claims he may have against the Town and the Releasees at the time of the execution of this Agreement arising out of or related to his employment or the cessation of his employment with the Town, regardless of whether the claims have been asserted or are known at the time of the execution of this Agreement, including, but not limited to, any claim of any form of discrimination Kalba may have under federal, State or local law or regulation and Town policy, including, but not limited to, any action against the Town or the Releasees under New York Executive Law Section 290, et seq., the New York Civil Service and Education Laws, 28 U.S.C. Section 1343, 42 U.S.C. Section 2000e-5, 42 U.S.C. Sections 1983 and 1988, and any claim for breach of the CSEA collective bargaining agreement or any other contract, infliction of emotional distress, pain and suffering or other tort, as well as any claim for wages owed.

11. Kalba acknowledges that he is and has been represented by counsel throughout the negotiation of this Agreement. Kalba certifies that he has carefully reviewed this Agreement and fully understands each and every word and its meaning and full effect, including the release of claims, and this paragraph.

12. Kalba's signing of this Agreement has not been rushed in any way. He certifies that he has voluntarily entered into this Agreement. Kalba acknowledges that neither the Town nor the Releasees, or any of the Town's or Releasees' agents, representatives, employees or attorneys has made any representations concerning the terms or effects of this Agreement other than those contained herein. Kalba confirms that he does not rely in any way upon any belief he may have that such representations have been made.

13. This Agreement is made and entered into in the State of New York and shall be in all respects interpreted, enforced and governed under the laws of that State. The language of all parts of this Agreement shall be in all cases construed as a whole, according to its fair meaning, and not strictly for or against any of the parties, even though one of the parties may have drafted it.
