ADVANCED WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY BIDS THAT ARE  
INELIGIBLE FOR AWARD  
GENERAL & MECHANICAL CONSTRUCTION (CONTRACT G)

COUNCILMAN KENT offered the following resolution, was seconded  
by COUNCILMAN LULL :

WHEREAS the Town Board has solicited bids for the General and Mechanical Construction (Contract G) for the Town's proposed Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS the Town has received bids, among others, from W.H.M. Plumbing & Heating Contractors, Inc. and Philip Ross Industries, Inc.; and

WHEREAS the Town's consulting engineers have reported to the Town Board that the bids submitted by the two aforesaid bidders are non-responsive and failed to comply with the literal requirements of the bid specifications with respect to qualifications for bidders in that they failed to provide a minimum of five (5) projects of similar size and nature and type wherein the bidder was the prime contractor and which have been in operation for a period of not less than one (1) year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead hereby determines that the bids submitted by W.H.M. Plumbing & Heating Contractors, Inc. and Philip Ross Industries, Inc. for the General and Mechanical Construction (Contract G) for the Town's proposed Advanced Wastewater Treatment Facility are not eligible for award for the reasons stated above. Any objections to this determination must be made in writing and filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead no later than the close of business on Friday, May 21, 1999; and it is further
