## EXTENDS LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY REGARDING RIMLAND BUILDING

### COUNCILMAN LULL

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution Number 77, adopted on January 30, 1998, the Town Board declared a local State of Emergency regarding the condition of the east wall of the Rimland Building; and

**WHEREAS**, New York State Executive Law Article 2-B provides, in part that said State of Emergency shall run for a period not more than five (5) days; and

**WHEREAS**, notwithstanding the above, upon reconsideration of all the relevant facts and circumstances, a local State of Emergency may be extended for additional periods of not more than five (5) days during the pendency of the local State of Emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board, upon review of all the relevant facts and circumstances herein determines that the local State of Emergency regarding the Rimland Building should be extended for an additional period of not more than five (5) days.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead be and hereby extends the local State of Emergency as declared by Resolution Number 77 beginning at 9:00 o'clock a.m. on February 9, 1998 and ending at 9:00 o'clock a.m. on February 13, 1998; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board be and hereby authorizes the Town Supervisor to exercise the authority promulgated to him under New York State Executive Law Article 2-B; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that all other terms and conditions contained in Resolution Number 77 shall remain in full force and effect.
