WHEREAS, the Estate of Helen Schott has petitioned the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead to construct a lateral sewer in Madison Street pursuant to Section 199 of the Town Law to consist of excavation, pipe, fittings, manhole, and pavement restoration, and

WHEREAS, a cost estimate has been prepared by Young and Young, Riverhead, New York, and is on file with the Town Clerk of the Town of Riverhead for public inspection, and

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of the final order, the Estate of Helen Schott will deposit with the Riverhead Sewer District the sum of \$10,000, the estimated cost of construction, engineering, legal and publication and contingencies and is bound to pay to the Town of Riverhead any additional costs and expenses so that the lateral shall be constructed without cost to the Riverhead Sewer District,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Town Law Section 199, the Town Board, as governing body of the Riverhead Sewer District, on its own motion, resolves that a public hearing will be held at the Riverhead Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, in said Town, on the 7th day of March, 1995, at 7:10 o'clock p.m. prevailing time, on the matter of the construction of a lateral sewer in Madison Street, pursuant to Section 199 of the Town Law to consist of: excavation, pipe, fittings, manhole and pavement restoration at an estimated cost of \$10,000, which sum will be deposited with the Riverhead Sewer District by Petitioner prior to the adoption of the final order, and which lateral shall be constructed without cost to the Riverhead Sewer District, and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof, concerning the same, and to take such action as required or authorized by

law, and be it further
