Smith, Esq. on behalf of 1994 Soundview Golf, Inc. as owner, to provide for the Recreational Zoning Use District in order to allow for the development of a golf club upon real property located on the northerly side of Sound Avenue, Wading River; such property more particularly described as 0600-57-1-1.4, and

WHEREAS, the Riverhead Planning Board as lead agency in this action has determined the petition to be Type I without a significant impact upon the environment and that an Environmental Impact Statement need not be prepared, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has referred the application to the Riverhead Planning Board for its report and recommendation such Planning Board recommending that the zoning amendment be approved with conditions, and

WHEREAS, the Riverhead Town Board has carefully considered the merits of the change of zone petition, the SEQRA record created to date, the report of the Planning Department, the report of the Planning Board, the record of public hearing, as well as all other relevant planning, zoning and environmental information, now

THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that in the matter of the change of zone petition of 1994 Soundview Golf, Inc., the Riverhead Town Board hereby finds the following:

FIRST: That the subject real property meets the criteria for inclusion in the Recreational Zoning Use District and by inference conforms to the goals of the Wading River Hamlet Study;

SECOND: That the open areas of the golf course use are considered to be open space pursuant to Section 278 of the Town Law and Article XIX of the Riverhead Zoning Ordinance which support the clustering of residential lots;

- THIRD: That the application of the recreational overlay district would result in a reduction in the total number of residential lots to be created within the map of Sound Breeze which will have a positive fiscal impact upon the Riverhead School District;
- FOURTH: That the environmental impacts of the proposed zone change have been identified and that mitigation measures have been identified by the Planning Board as Lead Agency;
- FIFTH: That the SONIR Groundwater Model for the proposed golf course assuming fertilizer application rate of 3 lbs./1000 square feet, resulted in the nitrogen concentration of recharge irrigation not to exceed 4.17 mg/l; such concentration less than existing New York State and County of Suffolk standards;
- SIXTH: That the nitrogen loading factor attributable to the golf course together with single family development is considered to be less than that standard inherent in Article 6 of the Suffolk County Sanitary Code;
- SEVENTH: That residential areas within the general vicinity of the proposed golf course are served by the Riverhead Water District. However, there exist private wells in use within the general vicinity of the project site. All residential lots within the subdivision will be served by the Water District. There are no plans by the Riverhead Water District to provide new supply wells in any area north of Sound Avenue;
- EIGHTH: That the proposed golf course is to be irrigated by use of an existing on-site well and is to be irrigated at a rate which is considered average for golf courses on Long Island;
- NINTH: That an integrated golf course management plan (IGCMP) for the golf course will be submitted to the Town. The contemplated IMP would require that the pesticides to be used would be primarily post-emergents to be employed on an as needed basis. Further, based upon the findings of A Groundwater Monitoring Study for Pesticides and Nitrates Associated with Golf Courses on Cape Cod (Cohen, et.al.), adherence to an integrated

- SEVENTH: golf course management plan would prevent groundwater impacts due to pesticides;
- TENTH: That the number of motor vehicle trip ends and the direction of movements has been quantified with the peak hour trip generation of the golf course alternative being equivalent to the trips expected to be generated by the original subdivision of 218 lots. Due to this equivalency, the levels of service of intersections and public roadways in the general vicinity of the project site will not be less than that originally determined and accepted in the environmental review of the map of Sound Breeze;
- ELEVENTH: That the intersection of North Country Road and Sound Avenue is considered to be the area most impacted by those motor vehicles to be generated by the project and that the level of service of this intersection will be improved by a proposed Department of Transportation reconfiguration of this intersection;
- TWELFTH: That the proposed golf course alternative is expected to result in 127+ acres of contiguous open space as compared to the 65+ acres of noncontiguous open space depicted upon the "Map of Sound Breeze". Additionally, the golf course is expected to result in the retention of 30+ acres of land to remain in natural vegetation with an additional 9+ acres to be revegetated with naturally occurring vegetation;
- THIRTEENTH: That the proposed golf course is being designed to take advantage of existing treed areas and natural topography to the greatest extent possible. Cut and fill on the property will be balanced to the greatest extent practicable with the exception of the need for the removal of no more than 150,000 cubic yards of material from the site. The project site may be capable of sustaining an exportation of surplus soil in a volume less than the volume identified. Such determination to be made by virtue of site plan review;
- FOURTEENTH: That the proposed golf course plan provides for dedication to the Town of Riverhead of a 5.6+ acre freshwater wetland area; such dedication resulting in the protection of the wetland;

FIFTEENTH: That the subject real property has been identified as one of very few potential parcels within the Hamlet of Wading River currently eligible for inclusion within the Recreational Overlay Zoning Use District to be used as a golf course;

SIXTEENTH: That the DEIS accepted for the original subdivision identified the displacement of less tolerant species due to the construction of roadways and residential buildings. The addition of 60+ acres of non-developed area, by virtue of golf course construction, is expected to provide additional habitat for these species; and

BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, that based upon its findings, the Riverhead Town Board approves the change of zone petition of 1994 Soundview Golf, Inc. subject to the following:
