ORDER CALLING PUBLIC HEARING, RE: INCREASE AND IMPROVEMENT TO THE RIVERHEAD SEWER DISTRICT FLOW DIVERSION FOR ENHANCED NITROGEN REMOVAL

Adopted: June 28, 1996

Councilman Prusinowski offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman Lull

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, has duly caused to be prepared a plan and estimate of cost relating to the increase and improvement of the facilities of the Riverhead Sewer District of said Town by Malcolm Pirnie, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, such overall plan encompasses the installation and construction of piping, pumps, valves and appurtenances related thereto for flow diversion for enhanced nitrogen removal for the Riverhead Sewer District, and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount proposed to be expended for said overall improvements is \$198,000 which shall be allocated and charged as the cost of increasing and improving the facilities of the Riverhead Sewer District and shall be borne by the entire District to be paid from existing funds; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to call a public hearing on the question of the increase and improvement of the facilities of the entirety of said Riverhead Sewer District as described above, in accordance with the provisions of Section 202-b of the Town Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. A public hearing will be held at St. John the Parish Hall Wading River, Riverhead, New York, in said Town, on the 16th day of July, 1996, at 7:20 o'clock p.m., prevailing time, on the question of the increase and improvement of the facilities of the Riverhead Sewer District in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, in the manner described in the preambles hereof, and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof, concerning the same, and to take such action as is required or authorized by law.

Section 2. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and

directed to cause a copy of the notice of public hearing to be published in the July 3rd edition of the Suffolk Life Newspaper, the newspaper hereby designated as the official newspaper for this purpose, and in Newsday, and also to cause a copy thereof to be posted on the sign board of the Town, such publication and posting to be made not less than ten, nor more than twenty days before the date designated for the public hearing.

Section 3. The project described in the preambles hereto is hereby determined to be an "unlisted action" under the State Environmental Quality Review Act, the implementation of which, as proposed, will not result in any significant environmental effects.

Section 4. The notice of public hearing shall be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, will meet at St. John the Baptist Parish Hall, Wading River Riverhead, New York, at 7:20 o'clock p.m. prevailing time, on July 16, 1996, for the purpose of conducting a public hearing in relation to an increase and improvement of the facilities of the Riverhead Sewer District in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, wherein such overall plan encompasses the installation and construction of piping, pumps, valves and appurtenances related thereto for flow diversion for enhanced nitrogen removal for the Riverhead Sewer District at a maximum amount in the sum of \$198,000, and

At said public hearing said Town Board will hear all persons interested in the subject matter thereof.

**TOWN OF RIVERHEAD****Resolution # 516****AMENDS SITE PLAN OF EAST END RECYCLING AND COMPOSTING CO.**

Councilman Kwasna offered the following

resolution, which was seconded by Councilman Wittmeier:

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution # 530, dated August 3, 1993, the Riverhead Town Board did approve the site plan of John D. Cameron, as agent for East End Recycling & Composting Co., for the construction of a 500 ton per day recycling and composting facility, and related site improvements located at the south side of Middle Country Road (New York State Route 25), Calverton, New York, known and designated as Suffolk County Tax Map Number 0600-116-1-1, and

**WHEREAS**, John D. Cameron, as agent for East End Recycling & Composting Co., has requested that a modification of said site plan approval in regard to the phased construction of a recycling and composting facility, as per site plans (sheets SP-1 through SP-4) each dated May, 1996, as prepared by Cameron Engineering, 1400 Old Country Road, Suite 410, Westbury NY 11590, and elevation drawings dated May, 1996, (Sheet A2) as prepared by Cameron Engineering, 1400 Old Country Road, Suite 410, Westbury NY 11590 be approved by the Riverhead Town Board, and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Department has reviewed such modification and has recommended that the Town Board accept such modification with the conditions indicated below, and

**WHEREAS**, this Town Board has reviewed the modification aforementioned, and

**WHEREAS**, the site plan amendment fee, as required by Section 108-131 B(3) of the Code of the Town of Riverhead has been received and deposited as per Receipt Number 96-17306 of the Office of the Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead does hereby approve the amended site plan of John D. Cameron, as agent for East End Recycling & Composting Co., to provide for the phased construction of a recycling and composting facility, as per site plans (sheets SP-1 through SP-4) each dated May, 1996, as prepared by Cameron Engineering, 1400 Old Country Road, Suite 410, Westbury NY 11590, and elevation drawings dated May, 1996, (Sheet A2) as prepared by Cameron Engineering, 1400 Old Country Road, Suite 410, Westbury NY 11590, upon the condition that Phase 1 of the plans include the following:

- 1) the restoration of the existing farm house and barn, and water tower, pursuant to resolution #530 of 1993, as specified by drawing numbers G7 and A3 of the approved site plan of August 3, 1993, to be applied for and performed simultaneously with the tipping/transfer building;
- 2) the provision of all landscaped areas and fencing pursuant to resolution #530 of 1993 as specified by drawing number G8 of the approved site plan of August 3,

1993, as further redlined by the Planning Department in regard to the location of the fencing and as initialled by a majority of the Town Board, and subject to the submission of a detailed planting schedule to the Planning Department for approval prior to the issuance of a building permit, the implementation of which is to be simultaneous with the construction of the tipping/transfer building;

- 3) the provision of an internal roadway to a point 840 linear feet from the northern property line pursuant to resolution #530 of 1993 as specified by drawing G1 of the approved site plan of August 3, 1993, the construction of which is to be simultaneous with the construction of the tipping/transfer building;
- 4) the provision of those improvements within the New York State right of way, pursuant to resolution #530 of 1993, as specified by drawing number G1 of the approved site plan of August 3, 1993, the construction of which is to be simultaneous with the construction of the tipping/transfer station;
- 5) the tipping area shall employ an air filtration system designed to remove odors from internal air prior to exhaust from the building; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the tipping area shall only accept those wastes identified in resolution number 295 of 1993, which accepted lead agency findings and approved the special permit for the facility; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that all other improvements depicted on the site plan approval by resolution #530 of 1993 shall be completed as Phase II, provided that all necessary permit applications are received, in complete form, within twelve (12) months of August 3, 1996. In the event that complete applications are not submitted by the date indicated, the site plan approval for Phase II shall be deemed expired; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that all other improvements, terms and conditions of Town Board resolution #530, dated August, 1993, shall remain in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to John D. Cameron as agent for East End Recycling & Composting Co., the Riverhead Planning Department, Building Department, Town Engineer, Assessors' Office, and Office of the Town Attorney.
