

417 RESCINDS RESOLUTION #354 AUTHORIZING THE CLOSING OF THE
NEW YORK STATE BOAT RAMP AT JAMESPORT

COUNCILPERSON Prusinowski offered the following resolution, which was seconded by COUNCILPERSON Stark :

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead was concerned for the safety of its citizens and their property due to the non-navigable entrance to East Creek Marina inlet at Jamesport, New York; and

WHEREAS, Resolution #354 adopted by this Town Board on May 24, 1990, resolved that effective May 29, 1990, the New York State boat ramp at East Creek Marina, Jamesport, New York, was to be closed; and

WHEREAS, the State of New York Department of Environmental Conservation caused a permit to be issued allowing the County of Suffolk to dredge the entrance to East Creek at Jamesport, New York; and

WHEREAS, the entrance to East Creek at Jamesport, New York, is now navigable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that Resolution #354 adopted by the Town Board on May 24, 1990, be and is hereby rescinded; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to Richard Smith at East Creek Marina, the Recreation Department, the Bay Constable, Riverhead Police Department and to the Town Attorney's Office.

418 WAIVES RESTRICTIONS OF CHAPTER 46 OF THE RIVERHEAD TOWN CODE

COUNCILPERSON Civiletti offered the following resolution, which was seconded by COUNCILPERSON Lombardi :

WHEREAS, the East End Arts Council, through the Riverhad Chamber of Commerce, is holding a Jazz Festival at the public parking district field located on the Peconic River on June 30, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverhead is also holding a fireworks display at said public parking district field on the Peconic River on June 30, 1990; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Town Board to waive the restrictions of the consumption of alcohol under Section 46-5 of the Riverhead Town Code.

RESOVLED, that the restrictions under Section 46-5 of the Riverhead Town Code be and are hereby waived during the Jazz Festival and the fireworks display; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Riverhead Police Department, the East End Arts Council, the Riverhead Chamber of Commerce and the Town Attorney's Office.

419 WAIVES MOORING RESTRICTIONS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE RIVERHEAD TOWN CODE

COUNCILPERSON Lombardi offered the following resolution, which was seconded by COUNCILPERSON Civiletti:

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead is sponsoring a fireworks display at the Peconic River Municipal Parking Field; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverhead anticipates that the Peconic River adjacent to the Peconic River Park and Municipal Parking Field in the Town of Riverhead will be used for observation of the fireworks; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to waive the anchoring, docking and mooring restrictions of Section 106-6 of the Riverhead Town Code adjacent to the Peconic River Park and Municipal Parking Field in the Town of Riverhead from June 29, 1990, through July 2, 1990.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the restrictions under Section 106-6 of the Riverhead Town Code be and are hereby waived for the waters adjacent to the Peconic River Park and Municipal Parking Field from June 29, 1990, through July 2, 1990; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Riverhead Police Department, the Bay Constable and the Town Attorney's Office.

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Loyal Order of Moose, Bay Constable, the Riverhead Police Department and the Town Attorney's Office.
