CONSERVATION LAW WITH RESPECT TO THE PECONIC RIVER

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment is in conformance with the alternative boundary of the designated Peconic River area as resolved by the Riverhead Town Board and submitted into the DEC public hearing record; and

WHEREAS, this amendment is in conformance with the screening report for the Peconic River within the Town of Riverhead as compiled by the Towns of Riverhead, Brookhaven and Southampton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Riverhead Town Board support this amendment to the Environmental Conservation Law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the judgement of the Riverhead Town Board that the subject amendment will serve to both ensure the free flowing nature of the Peconic River, ensure the protection and enhancement of landowners in the enjoyment of their property and provide the participation of the local government in the process to achieve the goals of the Act.

LITHUANIAN HERITAGE

P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS: THE FORCED INCORPORATION OF LITHUANIA INTO THE SOVIET UNION OCCURRED ON AUGUST 3rd, 1940 - AN ACTION NEVER RECOGNIZED BY THE UNITED STATES; AND,

WHEREAS: ON FEBRUARY 24th, 1990 THE CITIZENS OF LITHUANIA THROUGH THEIR LEGISLATIVE'S VOTE STATED CLEARLY AND FORCEFULLY THEIR DESIRE FOR SELF-DETERMINATION AND INDEPENDENCE; AND

WHEREAS: THE LITHUANIAN LEGISLATURE RESPONDED TO THEIR CITIZENS AND DECLARED THE RESTORATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA ON MARCH 11th, 1990; AND,

WHEREAS: VYTAUTAS LANDSBERGIS, NEWLY-ELECTED PRESIDENT OF THE LITHUANIAN LEGISLATURE, HAS SOUGHT THE SUPPORT OF OUR NATION IN HIS NEGOTIATIONS WITH MIKHAIL GORBACHEV, PRESIDENT OF THE SOVIET UNION.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT WE, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF RIVERHEAD, LONG ISLAND, NEW YORK, SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGE THE PEOPLE OF LITHUANIA IN THEIR STRUGGLE FOR DEMOCRACY AND CALL UPON PRESIDENT GEORGE BUSH TO FORMALLY SUPPORT THE POSITION OF THE LITHUANIAN LEGISLATURE AND TO COMMUNICATE THIS SUPPORT TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SOVIET UNION.
