343 ORDER CALLING PUBLIC HEARING, RE: INCREASE AND IMPROVEMENT TO THE RIVERHEAD SEWER DISTRICT, IMPROVEMENTS TO PUMP STATIONS

COUNCILMAN PRUSINOWSKI

Councilperson _____ offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilperson **COUNCILMAN STARK**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, has duly caused to be prepared a map, plan and estimate of cost relating to the increase and improvement of the facilities of the Riverhead Sewer District of said Town; and

WHEREAS, such overall plan encompasses the renovation and improvement of the existing pump station facilities located at Cranberry Street, Howell Avenue, East Main Street, Elton Street, and the DeFriest Station on Route 25, and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount proposed to be expended for said overall improvements is \$622,440 which shall be allocated and charged as the cost of increasing and improving the facilities of the Riverhead Sewer District and shall be borne by the entire District to be paid from existing funds; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to call a public hearing on the question of the increase and improvement of the facilities of the entirety of said Riverhead Sewer District as described above, in accordance with the provisions of Section 202-b of the Town Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, by the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. A public hearing will be held at the Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, in said Town, on the 1st day of June, 1993, at 7:10 o'clock p.m., prevailing time, on the question of the increase and improvement of the facilities of the Riverhead Sewer District in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, New York, in the manner described in the preambles hereof, and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof, concerning the same, and to take such action as is required or authorized by law.

Section 2. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a copy of the notice of public hearing to be published once in the Suffolk Life Newspaper, the newspaper hereby designated as the official newspaper for this purpose, and also to cause a copy thereof to be posted on the sign board of the Town, such publication and posting to be made not less than ten, nor more than twenty days before the date designated for the

public hearing.

Section 3. The project described in the preambles hereto is hereby determined to be an "unlisted action" under the State Environmental Quality Review Act, the implementation of which, as proposed, will not result in any significant environmental effects.

Section 4. The notice of public hearing shall be in substantially the following form:
