650 CONDITIONAL ORDER FOR EXTENSION TO THE RIVERHEAD SEWER DISTRICT TO SERVE CASILEN CORPORATION - OSBORNE AVENUE DEVELOPMENT

Councilman COUNCILMAN STARK offered the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman ~~COUNCILMAN PRUSINOWSKI~~

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed by the owners of Casilen Corporation for an extension to the Riverhead Sewer District to serve their project located on Osborne Avenue, Riverhead, New York, as more particularly described in the attached description, and

WHEREAS, a map and plan dated August 26, 1992, has been prepared by Malcolm Pirnie, consulting engineers to the Riverhead Sewer District and is on file for public inspection in the Office of the Riverhead Town Clerk during regular business hours, and

WHEREAS, the extension comprises the construction of a new lift station within the development to be owned and operated by the applicant and connection by force main in the bed of Osborne Avenue and Route 58 to a manhole as more particularly described in the map and plan, and

WHEREAS, all costs associated with this extension shall be borne by the applicant and the applicant will be required to pay for denitrification pursuant to resolution 500 of 1992 no net increase in the amount of \$6.50 per gallon of daily flow, with an estimated flow of 43,500 gallons per day, and

WHEREAS, Malcolm Pirnie has developed two alternatives for consideration by the Town Board for necessary improvements to existing pump stations and the construction of a new pump station at the applicant's property and necessary force main at a cost to the applicant not to exceed \$1,234,000, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the 6th day of October, 1992, and all persons wishing to be heard were heard,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED that the Town Board, as governing body of the Riverhead Sewer District, upon the proceedings and record of the hearing had herein, determines that the extension to the Riverhead Sewer District as petitioned by Casilen Corporation to serve their project located on Osborne Avenue, Riverhead, New York, as more particularly described in the attached description, wherein the extension comprises the construction of a new lift station within the development to be owned and operated by the applicant and connection by force main in the bed of Osborne

Avenue and Route 58 to a manhole as more particularly described in the map and plan, is in the best interest of the district and will benefit the property to be served, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board adopts a Findings Statement which is incorporated herein, wherein it determines that the construction of a new lift station within the development to be owned and operated by the applicant and connection by force main in the bed of Osborne Avenue and Route 58 to a manhole as more particularly described in the map and plan is a Type II action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act which will not have a significant impact upon the environment, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this extension is conditioned and shall not become effective until the conditions contained herein are complied with; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the cost of installation of said new lift station and connection by force main is \$1,234,000, to be paid by the applicant, all being constructed subject to the following conditions:

1. The owner grants a permanent, unobstructed subsurface easement for the installation and maintenance of sewer mains and appurtenances;

2. The owner has posted a bond or letter of credit covering the cost of construction in the amount of \$1,234,000;

3. Key money to be posted by cash or bond in the amount of \$282,750;

4. Subject to public bidding by the Town of Riverhead;

5. Subject to further approval by this Town Board of the total number of units to be constructed by Casilen Corporation;

6. The applicant shall make no further changes in the scope of the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that when the conditions called for herein have been completed, the Town Clerk shall cause a copy of this Order to be recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Suffolk County and filed with the New York State Comptroller, and
