5. The site plan to be submitted to the Town Board, as required by Article XXVI of the Riverhead Zoning Ordinance, shall depict that area for dedication to the Riverhead Water District to provide for that wellfield as improved to the specifications of the Riverhead Water District;
6. The special permit is subject to the approval of the Suffolk County Sewer Agency with regard to the location of the proposed wastewater collection and treatment system;
7. The special permit is subject to the approval of the Suffolk County Department of Health Services with regard to the design and operation of the proposed wastewater collection and treatment system;
8. The special permit is subject to the further approval of this Town Board acting as the governing body of the Riverhead Sewer District;
9. The special permit is subject to approval by the Suffolk County Department of Health Services and subject to the preparation of a condominium map or homeowner's association subdivision in a form in accord with the regulation of the Suffolk County Planning Commission and the Riverhead Town Planning Board and the approval upon recommendation of the Suffolk County Planning Commission by the Riverhead Planning Board, pursuant to Section 108-20 of the Code of the Town of Riverhead and other applicable laws and rules;
10. The special permit is subject to the posting of bonds and/or the payment of fees as required by the Riverhead Town Code upon condominium map approval; and

**BE IT FURTHER**

**RESOLVED**, that due to the findings and conditions enumerated the Riverhead Town Board hereby overrides the recommendation of the Suffolk County Planning Commission, and

**BE IT FURTHER**

**RESOLVED**, that a certified copy of said resolution be forwarded to M.H. of L.I., Inc. or their agent, Town of Riverhead Planning Board, Suffolk County Planning Commission, and Town Attorney.
