AWARDS BID FOR REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF SLUDGE CAKE AND GRIT/SCREEN WASTE

WHEREAS, the Town Board, by Resolution #317 adopted on May 1, 2018, authorized the Town Clerk to publish and post a notice to bidders for sealed bids for Removal and Disposal of Sludge Cake and Grit/Screen Waste; and

WHEREAS, four (4) bids were received, opened and read aloud on the 22nd day of May, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. at Town Hall, 200 Howell Avenue, Riverhead, New York, the date, time and place given in the Notice to Bidders; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent for the Town of Riverhead Sewer District did review and evaluate all four responses to the bid solicitation and recommends that the bid be awarded to Tully Environmental.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board, as governing body of the Town of Riverhead Sewer District, awards the bid for Removal and Disposal of Sludge Cake and Frit/Screen Waste to Tully Environmental; and be it further

RESOLVED, that, pursuant to the bid specifications (Item 8 "Security for Faithful Performance and Maintenance", Tully Environmental shall submit the required Performance Bond equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the bid within ten (10) days after this Notice of Award; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this resolution to Tully Environmental, 127-50 Northern Boulevard, Flushing, NY 11368, the Purchasing Department and the Town of Riverhead Sewer District attention: Superintendent Reichel; and be it further

RESOLVED, that all Town Hall Departments may review and obtain a copy of this resolution from the electronic storage device and, if needed, a copy of same may be obtained from the Office of the Town Clerk.
